SUPPORT PERSON HEARING - DECISION

CASE No. 3

Event:	Race:

Procedural Matters:

Facts found:

1. During the night, Mr. Harrison, the coach of CAN Laser RDL and Mr. Dold, the coach of USA Laser STD, took Mr. Dold's coach boat from its mooring at Boat Park 3.
2. They drove out from the Aarhus commercial harbour for swimming, with two additional persons aboard.
3. No 'OPEN' or 'CLOSED' flags were displayed for Gates 2 and 3.
4. At 5:00 am the security of the boat park called Mr. Hjerrild, the Event Sailing Manager.
5. The security informed him that one of the coach boats was being stolen and driven out from the harbour.
6. The Police were informed about the incident.
7. About 45 minutes later the boat returned to the harbour.
8. The Police were satisfied that the boat belonged to the owner and they left.
9. The boat park security called Mr. Hjerrild again.
10. They reported that the boat is back in the harbour.
11. Mr. Dold reported to the International Jury on the morning of August 2, 2018 about the incident.
12. Mr. Harrison and Mr. Dold apologised during the hearing.

Conclusion:

Mr. Harrison and Mr. Dold by entering the restricted area broke CAR 4.2(b).

Mr. Harrison CAN and Mr. Dold USA are prohibited going on the water until the end of the first day of their coached classes.
